National Science Week

National Science Week took place on 13-21 August 2022 all over Australia. The school theme for National Science Week 2022 was **Glass**: *More than meets the eye*. This year's theme is based on the UN International Year of Glass and showcases the properties and uses of glass, highlighting its versatility, importance, and prevalence in our world from phone screens to optical fibres. It also investigates glass as a part of our sustainable future.

A huge thank you to Mrs Mumford for her outstanding organisation of Science Week for our school. The children really enjoyed participating in science experiments on the day and we were so excited to welcome our parents to be part of this exciting educational event.



Check-in Assessment Years 3-6

The Check-In Assessment is an online reading and numeracy assessment for students in Years 3 to 9. The Check-In assessments are designed to provide teachers with formative assessments that can give an indication of how students are performing. The Check-in assessment includes:

- a reading assessment
- numeracy assessment
- a new writing assessment for Year 6 students only

Year 6 will complete these assessments in week 8 of this term, while Years 3 to 5 will complete the assessments early next term.

NAPLAN 2023

NAPLAN is moving to Term 1. In 2023, NAPLAN will be held from Wednesday 15 March to Monday 27 March.

Attendance Matters

Understandably, some mornings can be challenging to get students to school on time. However, it is important to note that regular lateness can have a negative impact on student learning. Just 5 minutes a day equates to 3 days of missed learning in the school year. It can also mean that your child misses important instructions to start the day's learning. It is hard for students to 'catch-up' with their peers when they arrive late each morning.

Kindergarten Enrolments - 2023

We are now taking enrolments for Kindergarten in 2023. Children may be enrolled in Kindergarten at the beginning of the school year if they turn five years of age on or before 31 July in that year. By law, all children must be enrolled in school by their sixth birthday. If you are unsure if your child is ready to start school or would like to access further information, please contact the school via email Copacabana-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au or phone 43821766. As part of the enrolment process, you will need to provide your child's original birth certificate, statement of complete immunisation from Medicare and proof of your current address (a minimum of 100 points of identification are required).

Moving out of the area

We have commenced our planning process for 2023 and student enrolment numbers have a large impact on this planning. To assist us with planning for 2023, we ask if you could notify the school office by phone or email if your child/children will not be returning to Copacabana Public School next year. Science & STEM News

We have been enjoying exploring this term's Material World.

We have already had lots of discussions about what materials are around us, what materials jobs are and what happens when materials mix.

Kindergarten were able to explore natural and man made materials using their senses.









Stage 1 had a great time exploring face masks and what makes a good one. They were able to identify the different layers of face masks and why the developers used certain materials.







Stage 2 have learnt about repurposing materials and how everyday objects can be changed but still have a purpose. They have done some excellent product design including detailed sketches of their new products.







Stage 3 continued to investigate gases and had fun with balloons. In the coming weeks we will be testing the viscosity of different liquids.






