Middle Session 11:50am - 12:50pm Mathematics - This week's topic - 3D Objects	<ul> <li>This week's topic - 3D Objects</li> <li>3D objects are shapes with three dimensions, such as width, height and depth. An example of a 3D shape is a prism or a sphere. 3D shapes are multidimensional and can be physically held.</li> <li>Watch the activities on seesaw for 3D objects.</li> <li>Complete the 1st worksheet in your work booklet on 3D objects</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>This week's topic - 3D Objects</li> <li>The main difference between 2D shapes and 3D objects are their dimensions. A 2D shape (two-dimensional) only has length and height as the dimensions. 2D shapes are flat, while 3D objects take up more space in three dimensions.</li> <li>Watch the activities on seesaw for 3D objects.</li> <li>Complete the 2nd worksheet in your work booklet on 3D objects</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>This week's topic - 3D Objects Different 3-dimensional objects include cubes, pyramids, spheres, and cones. You can find examples of 3D shapes in the world all around us. </li> <li>Watch the activities on seesaw for 3D objects.</li> <li>Complete the 3rd worksheet in your work booklet on 3D objects</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>This week's topic - 3D Objects</li> <li>All three-dimensional objects are different but have three primary properties in common. These main 3D shape properties include:</li> <li>* Faces: A face is a flat or curved surface on a 3D shape. For example, a cube has six faces, a cylinder has three and a sphere has just one.</li> <li>* Edges: An edge is where two faces meet. For example, a cube has none.</li> <li>* Vertices: A vertex is a corner where edges meet. The plural is vertices. For example, a cube has one vertex and a sphere has none.</li> <li>Watch the activities on seesaw for 3D objects</li> <li>Complete the 4th worksheet in your booklet on 3D objects</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>This week's topic - 3D Objects Now that you are very clever at recognising the difference between 2D shapes and 3D objects, can you explain to a grown up what those differences are and find some examples in your home. </li> <li>Watch the activities on seesaw for 3D objects.</li> <li>Complete the 5th worksheet in your work booklet on 3D objects which is a fun box activity.
